The School offers two semesters yearly (Fall, Spring – when scheduled, a Summer Session will be provided). Each course includes: (See pages 3 and 4).

SCHEDULE OF CLASSES;  
FALL SESSION:

Tuition is \$875.00; which includes \$650.00 for tuition, \$100.00 application fee, \$50.00 for book, and \$50.00 for supplies. A \$200.00 deposit is required to hold a student's place in the each course. Students may choose a payment plan, with the balance due divided into two additional payments of \$225.00 and \$400.00. These payments must be paid before the first session. If a course has not been completed by a student, the student may retake the class and will be charged only half of the full tuition. Fashion classes are held Mondays 8:30a.m. to 12:30p.m. and from 1:30p.m. to 5:30p.m, they are also held on Saturdays from 8:00a.m. to 12:30p.m.

#### FALL CLASSES:

SEPTEMBER 8<sup>TH</sup> THROUGH OCTOBER 27<sup>TH</sup>  
NOVEMBER 3<sup>RD</sup> THROUGH DECEMBER 22<sup>ND</sup>  
DECEMBER 29 THROUGH FEB 16<sup>TH</sup>.

#### CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

One hundred dollars (\$100) of the registration fee paid to the school by the Student may be retained as an enrollment or application fee. All amounts paid in excess of one hundred dollars (100) shall be refundable.

During the first twenty five percent (25%) of the program the refund shall be made on a prorated basis based on the total number of clock hours for which the program is licensed. At completion of 25% of the program the students owes 50% of the tuition. At completion of 50% of the program the student owes 75% of the tuition. At completion of 75% of the program the student owes 100% of the tuition

#### COURSE GRADING AND PREREQUISITES:

No previous fashion design coursework or experience is necessary for enrollment in the program. Your attendance and promptness is important. If you must miss a class, or class cancelled due to inclement weather, you can schedule a makeup in the following 8-week session. Students must complete eighty-five (85%) of the class to receive a certificate of completion. Less than eight-five Percent attendance will result in student probation. To remove probationary status, students must make-up missed classes in the following session if students are unable to attend the first two classes of the course, please make arrangements to transfer your enrollment to the following 8-week session by calling Our Office at (501)663-3242.

Our classes start promptly. If a student is more than 30 minutes late, they are Considered tardy, after being tardy three times, the student will be on probation. Students are responsible for work missed due to tardiness. After completing the course, you will have a basic understanding of the fundamental principles of Fashion Design, as well as an increased confidence in Fashion Design decisions. A Jamileh Kamran's School of Fashion certificate is awarded to each student upon completion of each course.

Progress will be determined by the quality of finished projects, according to School's chart list.

Each Course consists of 32 clock hours.

#### BASIC DESIGN (001):

Measuring the body correctly, and chart sizes for different size (4 HOURS)  
Different levels of construction (6 HOURS)  
Different method of sewing (10 HOURS)  
Drafting and making the variety of different skirts pattern (12 HOURS).

#### INTERMEDIATE DESIGN (002)

Drafting, constructing, and making different blouses (10 HOURS)  
Turn them into Dresses (10 HOURS)  
Tailoring the garments ( 12 HOURS)

#### ADVANCED DESIGN (003)

**GRADE SCALE:**

Each of these Courses (001, 002, and 003) will be graded based on the following four point scale:

A=4

B=3

C=2

D=1

F=0

Each Course will consist of several small projects that will lead up to the final project. Each individual project will be graded based on a 4 point scale. The grade which students receive on each course will depend upon how closely the student follows directions, completes the projects within given guidelines, their enthusiasm and level of improvement.

Transcript will be posted within thirty (30) calendar days of the end of each term or upon withdrawal of completion of students.
